Students in Year 3 and Year 5 are currently completing NAPLAN (National Assessment Platform- Literacy and Numeracy). NAPLAN assesses the literacy and numeracy skills that students are learning through the school curriculum and allows parents/carers to see how their child is progressing. It is just one aspect of a school's assessment and reporting process. It does not replace ongoing assessments made by teachers about students learning and growth, but it can provide teachers with additional information about students' learning. The NAPLAN testing window closes on Monday March 25.






