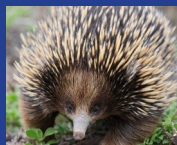

## **Education Week- Every Student Every Voice**

Welcome back to our families for the start of Term 3. We are already in Week 3 of the term and this week we are celebrating Education Week. The theme this year is 'Every Student Every Voice'. This year the South Coast Learning Community are hosting an Art Show at the Civic Centre in Bega until Friday afternoon. A selection of students' artwork will be displayed in the Centre and will also be displayed around the school. You are encouraged to attend the Art Show to vote for the People's Choice Award.

## **National Science Week**

Next week, Week 4, it is National Science Week. Destination Moon: more missions, more science is the school theme for this year. This theme is a way for teachers and their students to discover past missions to the Moon and space programs that have solved some of the seemingly unsolvable problems—and current and future space programs, operations and missions. Students will be participating in activities related to the theme throughout next week.

## **STEM- Project Fire Storm**

This term Mrs Collins is implementing a STEM project in collaboration with the local Rural Fire Brigade and the Bournda Environmental Education Centre called Project Fire Storm. The project relates and connects to the fires that Bemboka experienced last year and other significant bush fire events. Last week students participated in an introductory activity where they rotated between the 3 classes in groups to participate in different activities. Students watched a documentary about

bush fires, created short poetry verses and completed an art activity. On Monday August 12, students will be visiting the Bemboka RFS shed to participate in discussions about what happens at the shed. As the project progresses, students will be asked to select an interest group of either Prepare, Survive or Recover where they will be required to work as a team to design something related to their theme.

## **Zone Athletics Carnival**

The Zone Athletics Carnival will be held in Bega on Friday August 16. We have 6 students who successfully made it to Zone. They have received information related to the events they are participating in. Congratulations!

## STAGE 3 CANBERRA EXCURSION

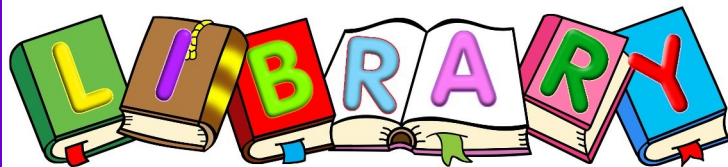

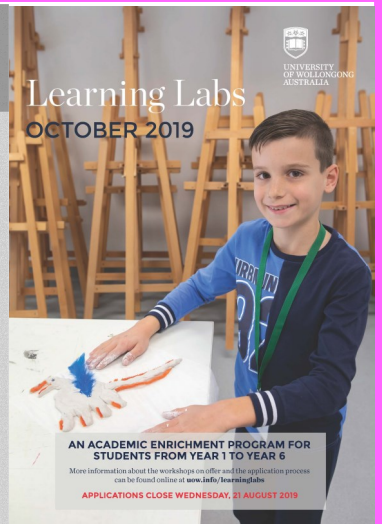
