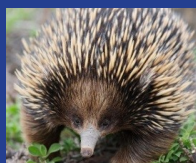

## **Early and Late Arrivals**

Please ensure when you are dropping off your child at school that you accompany them to the office to sign them in. Explanations are required for all late arrivals, early departures as well as absences. Parents must sign their child in/out of school at the office if they are late or leaving early. A slip will be printed for the student to present to the teacher when arriving late or given to a parent to present to a teacher if they are collecting their child early.

## **Visitors**
