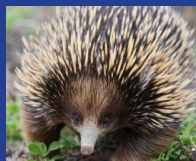

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Book Week

Last Friday November 13 we celebrated Book Week here at school. It was lovely to see all the students dressed as their favourite book character and watch them parade their costumes. Mrs K organised a 'Fungi Hunt' for students to complete and points and prizes were awarded to the teams. I would like to thank Mrs K for her organisation and preparation in holding this event and for making it a special, fun and uplifting day for the school. Thank you to all the families and parents for organising your child's costume and thank you to the students for making it an exciting and energetic day.

P&C Meetings

The Department of Education is now allowing P&C Meetings to be back on school site as long as it is outside of school hours. Our next P&C Meeting is Monday December 7.

Presentation Day

With the updated advice from the DoE we are now able to proceed with our presentation day celebration. We are holding the event during school hours on Tuesday December 15 and will record the presentation for families who would like to watch the recording later. The school must comply with the 4 square metre rule for all people participating and we will only be able to invite guests based on the total number of people who are able to be accommodated under the 4 square metre rule. The seating arrangements will need to ensure that there is enough space for social distancing of 1.5 metres between non-household members and guests will have to remain seated as much as possible to minimise mingling. We will be required to maintain a record of names and contact details for all attendees including school staff and visitors for at least 28 days after then event. The record is only used for purposes of contact tracing and will be stored confidentially and securely. At the

conclusion of our Presentation Day guests will be asked to leave in their household groups.

We are currently planning our Presentation Day ceremony at school and we will send out invitations to families once we know how many visitors we can invite. More information will be provided in the coming weeks.

Bournda Excursions

Today, **Yellow Learning Group** will have a visit from Bournda Environmental Education Centre (BEEC). They will study 'Science at school—our living world.' They will learn about external features of living things they discover in the playground and learn how to identify and group these living things based on their external features. They will also learn how these living things change as they grow.

Years 3 & 4 students will be going to BEEC next Tuesday 24 November to participate in a 'Bournda Challenge'. Parents need to transport students to BEEC by 10am and pick them up at 2.30pm.

Years 5 & 6 will be visiting BEEC on Thursday 3 December to participate in a 'Bournda Explorer' program. Parents will need to transport their child/ren to BEEC on the day. They need to arrive at BEEC by 10am and pick them up at 2.30pm. A note will be sent home soon.

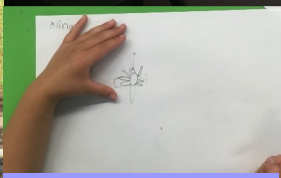

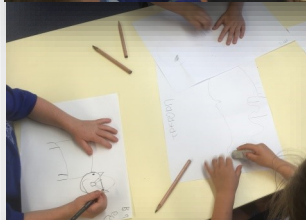
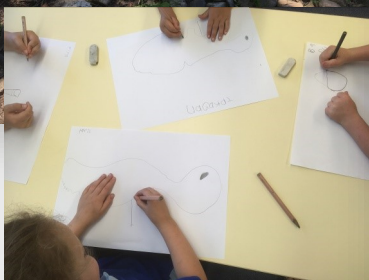
